This two story house was built in 1916 by A W Kavanaugh, who owned a local hardware store. Around 1940 it housed the Omar Hill Funeral Home and during WW II the upstairs rooms were rented as two apartments. The Paris family built the outdoor fireplace while they owned the home. The original steam-heated radiators still warm the house in the winter, although the system has been converted from coal to natural gas. The tunnel underground to the storm shelter is just one unique feature of this wonderful home. A huge shady yard both front and back and a shaded front porch offer visitors a relaxing atmosphere.
